INTRODUCTION TO MEX

2 DAY COURSE

ADVANCED TRAINING

1DAY COURSE

What do you need?

ONLINE

Participating in online training requires a reliable internet connection, a secondary screen, a webcam, a microphone, and an up-to-date web browser.

FACE TO FACE

This will also require access to a reliable internet connection and an up to date web browser. However, participants will only need an individual laptop, as the secondary screen content can be projected or viewed on a large communal screen.



LOGIN DETAILS

Start by providing all your details so that we can organise all training resources and get you started on the right foot in the training portal.



RELIABLE INTERNET

First up will be an internet speed test to check that you have a suitable and reliable connection to participate in the course and access resources.



BROWSER & DEVICE

An automatic check of your browser and system specifications is performed to ensure training resources can be accessed & used.
